Covid-19 Considerations

Guidelines

- If you have any symptoms of illness should stay home.
- If you are at high risk, we encouraged you to stay home.
- If you are uncomfortable attending service at this time, we encouraged you to stay home.
- Please practice (6 ft) social distancing and avoid large crowds
- Please practice good hygiene by washing your hands regularly.
- Wearing a **Mask is required**.

Masks

- Masks are required for indoor worship! The Wisconsin State Governor has mandated the use of cloth face masks while indoors at a public facility through the end of year (2020). We require the wearing of masks for all indoor events, there are no exceptions.
- If you do not have a mask when you arrive, we have them available in the entryway. If we see someone not wearing a mask in church, we will ask for them to leave. We are trying to protect everyone.

Entering the Church

- The doors will be propped open to minimize contact.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the doors as you enter the church.
- Masks are available in the church entryway if you did not bring your own.
- Members are asked to walk into the church and continue into the sanctuary and be mindful of the seating arrangements.
- Ushers/Deacons will be present to offer assistance in seating.

Seating in the Sanctuary

- Certain rows of chairs include 6-foot distancing between members.
- Households are encouraged to sit in the same roll pew.

- Those not of the same household may share a row with someone else as long as there is 6-feet in between.

The Service

- The worship flyer can be picked up at the entryway table at the front door of the church.
- Our worship service will last an hour (11:30 AM– 12:30 AM).

Leaving the Sanctuary

- You will be given directions by the church leadership at the end of the service to ensure leaving the church safely.
- Offering will be taken during the worship service. Ushers/Deacons will come by to collect the offering.
- Pastor will greet people outside of the church (wearing a mask), but won't be shaking hands.
- Grace Fellowship Church leadership will monitor the service and the preventive measures we have put into place. Some adjustments may be necessary as time goes along.
- We thank you for your cooperation in understanding the need to put these measures into place as we reopen our church and gather for worship.
- We pray that the Lord will bless our efforts to meet in person again and that he will keep every member and guest of our congregation safe.

Cleanliness

- High contact surfaces (pews & door handles) are cleaned after each service.
- A deeper cleaning will be done after each weekend of worship
- The church has high quality air filters in place to maintain the air quality.
- Bathrooms on the main and lower levels are available. If a child needs to use the restroom, an adult must accompany them.
